

## **School Site Council (SSC) LCAP Progress Update May, 2020**

As reported in our April School Site Council LCAP Progress Update, the COVID-19 pandemic and the shelter in place across the state, ACOE Court and Community schools are reporting the following **changes to LCAP requirements for 2020-21** from the California Department of Education (CDE).

### **COVID-19 Operations Written Report**

Executive Order (EO) N-56-20 was established on April 22, 2020, to address the impact of continued school closures in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and the local educational agencies' ability to conduct meaningful annual planning, and the ability to meaningfully engage stakeholders in these processes. EO N-56-20 issued timeline and approval waivers for the Local Control and Accountability Plan and Budget Overview for Parents as well as waving certain budgetary requirements. The Executive Order also established the requirement that a local educational agency (LEA) adopt a written report (**COVID-19 Operations Written Report**) to explain to its community the changes to program offerings the LEA has made in response to school closures due to the COVID-19 emergency and the major impacts of such closures on students and families.

#### **The COVID-19 Operations Written Report must include:**

- An overview explaining the **changes to program offerings** that the LEA has made in response to school closures to address the COVID-19 emergency and the **major impacts of the closures on students and families.**
- A description of how the LEA is **meeting the needs of its English learners, expelled (\*COE)/foster youth and low-income students.**
- A description of the steps that have been taken by the LEA to continue delivering **high quality distance learning opportunities.**
- A description of the steps that have been taken by the LEA to provide **school meals** while maintaining social distancing practices.
- A description of the steps that have been taken by the LEA to arrange for **supervision of students during ordinary school hours**

The descriptions provided should include sufficient detail yet be sufficiently succinct to promote a broader understanding of the changes the LEA has put in place and is not to exceed 300 words per each required element.

The 2020-21 Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) Annual Update is due to the CDE on December 15, 2020, while the new three-year LCAP for 2020-23, will follow the normal submission timeline requiring local board approval by June 30, 2021 and submission to the CDE by July 1, 2021.

Our commitment to our educational stakeholders has not changed and we will continue to seek input on the development of both the 2019-20 Annual Update and the new 2020-23 plan.
