



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to California Education Code 47605.6 and 47607, the Alameda County Board of Education will hold a public hearing on **Urban Montessori Charter School's material revision request** at its regular meeting. At this time the public may speak to the material revision request or any other item listed on the Board's agenda by following the remote guidelines below.

- 1) On June 13, 2017, the Alameda County Board of Education Trustees approved Urban Montessori Charter School's Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).
- 2) In accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding, Section 23.1.3 requires a material revision for changes in enrollment that represent a decrease from the annual enrollment originally projected in the charter petition by more than 10% percent in any given year.
- 3) Urban Montessori Charter School's enrollment for the 2021-22 school year meets the threshold for material revision and requests a revision to the enrollment projections originally approved in the charter petition.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Meeting of the Alameda County Board of Education (ACBOE) will be held on Tuesday, March 8, 2022 for a Regular Board Meeting with closed session at 4:30 PM and open session at 6:30 PM.
