1 Who we serve?

We primarily support **7th-10th grade youth impacted by the foster care system, unstable housing, and/or lack of academic support**, in addition to their families and caregivers, in Alameda County.

2 What do we do?

We offer **hands-on learning opportunities** with our after-school programs and pop-up experiences. We also provide **field trip opportunities, grocery and transportation support, school support, food and swag.**

3 Where are we located?

Our main after-school program, Project re:Fresh, is located in **Oakland**. We also host pop-ups at **youth shelters**, like Dreamcatcher, in addition to schools in **Pleasanton and Hayward**.

4 How to get involved?

Registration is open on a rolling basis, so you can **register any time before the end of the school year!** If you know a youth who might benefit from our support or you know a school/shelter that would like to host a pop-up, please reach out to us at any time.
