## Who Can Make a Request?

Cities, Community Partners, County Agencies/Departments, Schools, Special Districts, Transit Agencies, and Unincorporated Areas



### Available Local Resources?

Cities **must exhaust local resources** prior to submitting a resource request to County EOC.



### Identify Needed Resource

**Medical/Health Equipment:** included but not limited to personal protective equipment (PPE) such as gowns, masks, goggles, hand sanitizers, face shields to the Medical Health Operations Center.

**-OR-**

**All Other Resources:** included but not limited to food, facilities, personnel, supplies to the City EOCs.
