**Our Program:** The Alameda County Office of Education Infant & Family Support Program provides services to eligible children birth to 3 who have delays in one or more areas of development. We provide free educational opportunities in your home and community.

**Support and Services:** We recognize that the family is the most important influence on the growth and development of a child. We strive to support and partner with families to create fun, play-based strategies to allow children to practice new skills. We provide services where families are...visits in the home and community give us the opportunity to discover teachable moments within the context of everyday routines and activities. Young children learn best with in these routines and families are better prepared to support their child.

### Our Services Include:

- Weekly home or community based visits.
- Regular playgroups to bring families raising children with developmental delays together to play.
- Advocacy and transition support.
- Parent support.
- Inclusion support to help families integrate their child into their community.
- We have a transdisciplinary team who consult regularly to provide an integrated approach.
- Regular community events at local toddler spots (like the zoo, pumpkin patch or local kids' museums).
